

ELECTRIC VEHICLE OWNERS CAN CHARGE SMARTER WITH AN HOURLY RATE

The smart grid enables residents to take control of their electricity usage through innovative rate options like hourly pricing programs. We administer three such programs, serving 23,706 customers, including Mike McMahon, a veteran and EV owner in Lockport, IL.

SUPPORTING CHICAGO ENERGY BENCHMARKING

We supported the second year of Chicago's Energy Benchmarking Ordinance. In 2015, our Help Center handled more than five times the number of interactions over the previous year, resulting in an 85 percent compliance rate.

We've improved nearly 25,000 apartment units with energy efficient upgrades and generated more than \$35 million of private investment in energy conservation measures.


MAKING EXISTING BUILDINGS MORE COMFORTABLE AND EFFICIENT

We supported the development of a comprehensive state energy plan for Missouri and developed and are implementing a sustainability plan in Madison, Wisconsin.



PROMOTING SMART ENERGY POLICY AND PUTTING DATA TO WORK

What is community solar?

- 1.** Solar panels are installed in a sunny location somewhere in the community.
- 2.** Anyone with an electricity bill can subscribe to this community solar array and start accessing solar energy for their home.
- 3.** Each subscriber is credited with the electricity created by their share of the solar array right on their electric bill, regardless of where they live.



In addition to supporting the Illinois Clean Jobs coalition, we utilized our data and mapping expertise to help Cook County and the U.S. Department of Energy assess the opportunity for community solar in Illinois.

ENERGY COST DISCLOSURE PAYS OFF

In a first-of-its-kind analysis, we looked at 18 months of data since the City of Chicago passed a modernized energy cost disclosure ordinance and found that Chicago homes that disclose energy costs have a higher close rate and spend less time on the market.

Average sale price **without** energy costs disclosed:
\$352,000

Average sale price **with** energy costs disclosed:
\$356,576, a \$4,576 increase




ENGAGING NEW AUDIENCES IN REAL ESTATE
