We helped 127 building owners improve 21,924 units with our multifamily energy efficiency services.

We helped introduce the Clean Energy Jobs Act in the Illinois legislature, which would create more inexpensive renewable energy, and support Illinois' economically disadvantaged communities.

We expanded our energy efficiency offerings to provide deeper incentives to nonprofits that work with at-risk populations.



A new cohort of 41 trainees in Chicago and Marion, IL graduated from the Solar Jobs Training Program.



We removed home-based

We removed home-based health hazards and improved energy efficiency for 20 uninsured and Medicaid patients with severe asthma.



We provided free resources to help 759 childcare providers in Illinois address lead in drinking water. Blueprint, which demonstrates how efficiency advocates can engage real estate professionals to showcase high-performing homes.





Our analysis of energy burden and poverty was published in Social Forces, one of the premier sociology journals in the country.

We organized the Energy Education Challenge, where three central Illinois high schools competed to win money for their community through energy education.





We continue to act as collaborative thought partners by providing our support to national coalitions, like Energy Efficiency for All.

We helped develop the City of Lancaster Municipal Operations Climate Action Plan, which charts how the City can implement 30 strategies to reach net zero emissions.
